


Re: Shredded Cedar Bark

To whom it may concern:

Shredded Cedar Bark is derived from raw cedar bark and is ground to size. The point of origin for our bark is 2 local California saw mills. Cedar is a fibrous type of bark and is stringy in appearance. This is a very attractive bark. It has a variety of light and dark tans and due to the stringy make up, it is excellent on hillsides or uneven surfaces. The bark complies with the Cal-Trans Standard Specification 20-2.08 Mulch.

- **Cedar Bark is light and dark brown**
- **The particle sizes range from 3 " - 6 "**
- **The average full load size is 100 cy**
